You will be contacted by phone to arrange a date and time for your audition. You will audition behind a screen for a jury consisting of members of The Board of Trustees and the Contractor. You will be informed of the jury's decision by phone. Every musician accepted by the jury must belong to the union, The American Federation of Musicians, any local, prior to employment.

Rehearsals, performances, copywork and any other musical work shall be paid on the Wednesday following a week of activity. All proper deductions shall be withheld. The Corporation shall make contributions to the American Federation of Musicians & Employers Pension Fund on your behalf at the rate of 5 percent calculated on the gross wages for each and every service you perform. You are an employee, NOT an independent contractor.

The hours for school concerts will be between 0900 and 1500 on weekdays. Public concerts may occasionally be scheduled for weekday evenings but will usually take place on weekends; daytime or evening.

FYI, All engagements will originate from Wheeling. Musicians who wish to perform with THE AMERICAN HERITAGE ORCHESTRA should plan to reside in the Wheeling metro area, which includes eastern Ohio and western Pennsylvania.
